MEDICATIONS:

- 1. Resume all previous home medications at the previous prescribed dose and frequency
- 2. Start taking the following pain medications on an as-needed basis as prescribed.

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Keep your surgical site elevated above your heart for at least 5-7 days or longer to prevent swelling. This will improve your comfort and your overall recovery following surgery
- 2. Be alert for signs of infection including redness, streaking, odor, fever or chills. Be alert for excessive pain or bleeding and notify your surgeon immediately.

DIET AND COMFORT:

- 1. Return to your regular diet as tolerated. Begin with light or bland foods. Drink plenty of fluids.
- 2. Take your pain medication as prescribed. Take pain medication with food to minimize nausea.
- 3. Instead of the prescribed pain medication, you may take over-the-counter pain relievers such as Aleve and Tylenol if adequate pain relief is obtained.
- 4. Do not drink alcohol or drive while using prescription pain medications

ACTIVITY:

- 1. You are advised to go home directly from the hospital or surgical center. Restrict your activities.
- 2. Gently move your fingers which are free on an hourly basis to prevent stiffness and swelling
- 3. Do not push or pull on your operative fingers unless instructed to do so.
- 4. Do not drive for 24 hr after surgery or while using prescription pain medications
- 5. No lifting or pushing or pulling greater 2 pounds with the operative extremity until seen at the next postoperative visit.
- 6. Return to work will be determined at the next clinic visit. The patient will be restricted from all work activities from the time of surgery.

DRESSING CARE

- 1. Keep dressing clean and dry.
- 2. You may shower, but place plastic bag over dressing.
- 3. The patient should continue to wear the postoperative dressing for 5 days.

DRESSING CARE

- 1. Keep splint clean and dry.
- 2. You may shower, with a plastic bag over the splint. Should the splint become it wet it will need to be changed at our office.
- 3. The patient should continue to wear the postoperative splint until follow-up.
